Most hunts will require a hotel night upon arrival. We will book your hotel reservation for you if requested. Our preferred hotel in Arusha is 'Destination 3 Degrees'; our hunters receive a rate of \$170 per night to include room, dinner and breakfast. Many other options are available in Arusha.

Observers are welcome at \$500 per day.

Baiting vehicle and crew are available at \$600 per day (a 4-day minimum is required).
