- 1 on 1 guided safaris (One Professional Hunter / PH / Guide with one hunter)
- Luxury bush accommodation, all meals, local beverages (including limited alcoholic brands), and daily laundry service
- Trackers, skinners, and full camp staff
- Field preparation of trophies (skinning, salting, and tagging)
- 15% VAT (Value Added Tax) on daily rates and trophy fees

NIGHTLY RATE EXCLUDES

- Hotel accommodation before or after the contracted safari period (if required)
- Transfers to/from the international airport and hunting area (unless otherwise arranged)
- CITES licenses or special permits (where applicable)
- Trophy fees on animals on animals bagged, wounded and/or lost
- Gratuities for Professional Hunters and camp staff
- Transportation of trophies to taxidermist or dip & pack company
- Taxidermy costs, dipping, packing, crating, and shipping of trophies to final destination
- Bow and rifle hunting permits, importation fees and/or airport clearance (where applicable)
- Commercial or chartered flights as well as medical or travel expenses



TERMS OF BUSINESS

- To secure your booking, a non-refundable deposit of \$1,000 per person is required. This amount will be deducted from your final invoice at the conclusion of your hunt.
- Final invoice needs to be paid on the last day of the safari.
- Exchange rate on the last hunting day of departure will be used to convert into ZAR where applicable.
- All clients and observers are required to read and sign our indemnity form before commencement of any safari.
- Prices are subject to change without notice due to circumstances out of our control.
- Outfitter, when booking the safari, will determine all ground transportation costs by vehicle between airports and hunting areas if applicable.
- Zingela Limpopo Safaris accepts no responsibility for any illness, accident, claim or loss of whatsoever nature arising during and after the safari. Clients are advised to take out their own medical insurance and cancellation cover.

CANCELLATIONS & RESCHEDULING

- A minimum of 30 days' written notice is required for cancellations or rescheduling.

- Cancellations within 7 days of arrival result in forfeiture of deposits, and any rescheduling must occur within one year.
